FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW DO I APPLY? To be considered for a Foundation Scholarship, each item below must be received by the Foundation Office on or before the deadline:

- 1) This completed application form.
- 2) High school transcript, GED test results, or transcript from last college attended.
This may be omitted if you will have completed at least 12 credit hours of coursework at Zane State College before the deadline. You must have the equivalent of at least a 2.75 GPA on a 4.00 scale.
- 3) Two letters of recommendation.
Forms are available in the Foundation Office or you may request letters from two people who are familiar with your academic performance and personal background. The letters should cover work habits and initiative, class attendance, intellectual and technological abilities, leadership, length of relationship, accomplishments, and employment experience as applicable.
- 4) A copy of your federal tax return for the latest filing year. If you were claimed as a dependent on another person's return, submit a copy of that tax return as well.
- 5) A one-page description of your academic background, employment experiences, career goals, interests, or other information you would like considered.
- 6) Final results from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
If you need assistance, contact the Foundation Office or Office of Student Financial Aid. Additional items may be requested by the Office of Student Financial Aid. Your results will not be considered final until all additional items are submitted. Please apply early so that your final results are on file by March 31.

WHO CAN APPLY? Any student who will be enrolled at Zane State College and whose most recent cumulative GPA is 2.75 or higher.

HOW DO I SUBMIT MY APPLICATION MATERIALS? You may:

- 1) mail your items to Zane State College Foundation, 1555 Newark Road, Zanesville, OH 43701; or
- 2) return to the Foundation Office (College Hall, Room 119); or to the Willett-Pratt Training Center (Cambridge).

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE? The deadline for first consideration is March 15 of each year. Applications will continue to be accepted through June 1 of each year for Fall Quarter. Completed applications received after the June 1 deadline may be considered for scholarships only if funds remain.

HOW MUCH AND WHAT KIND OF SCHOLARSHIPS COULD I RECEIVE? The Foundation typically provides about \$65,000 to students each year. Generally, scholarships range from \$100 to \$1,000 per quarter. The Foundation Office determines which scholarship(s) you qualify for based on your situation and specific eligibility criteria established by donors.

WHAT IS THE ZANE STATE COLLEGE FOUNDATION? The Zane State College Foundation was established in 1984 by the College Board of Trustees. The Foundation exists to provide student scholarships, support professional development of employees, and assist in the acquisition of the latest technical laboratory equipment.
