Zane State College is accepting applications for adjunct faculty to teach courses in humanities and social sciences. Successful candidates will possess an earned master's degree in fine arts (music appreciation, introduction to theater), history, art history, literature, philosophy, sociology, psychology, Spanish, earth sciences, or other humanities areas from an accredited institution of high education or a master's degree with a minimum of 27 quarter or 18 semester graduate hours in the humanities discipline to be taught from an accredited institution. Teaching experience is preferred. The successful candidate will be available to teach evenings and/or weekend courses as assigned.

Two years of teaching experience, preferably in a two-year college setting, is desirable. Experience with curriculum development, using instructional technology, and distance learning is preferred.
