Qualifications:

Be 18 years or older

Qualify as a low income adult = under 200% of the FPG *or*

Be a Dislocated Worker – lost your job due to no fault of your own, unlikely to return to the occupation

Not possess a college degree, license or prior certification for employment in a demand occupation

Be interested in a short term training that can be completed in one calendar year or two year or less approved program. Whether just starting or have partially completed your program—we may be able to help

If male, you are required to have registered with Selective Service if you were born 1-1-1960 or after

If your training credential requires a background check to obtain? You must have a current background check to present as verification

Choose a training program that meets the criteria of the statewide demand occupation list

Be willing to cooperate with the entire process of the WIOA application and case management procedures

Complete all gathering of verifications and application forms
