

Academic Award Program

A scholarship program for recent high school graduates.



Notification

Once all documents are received, students will be notified of eligibility and asked to sign a scholarship agreement. Deadline to complete the scholarship agreement is two weeks prior to the start of the term. Students have up to one year after high school graduation to begin the scholarship.

Maintaining the Scholarship

- Students must enroll in and complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per term, except summer term. Students may choose not to enroll for summer, but it still counts as a term of eligibility.
- The scholarship expires 5 consecutive semesters after the first semester of enrollment.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 must be sustained.

Failure to meet any of the maintenance requirements will result in the loss of the academic award.

The Award

The Academic Award program provides scholarships for up to five consecutive semesters for qualified students. Awarded in half tuition and full tuition amounts, this scholarship can be used in addition to other grants and scholarships.

The total award amount will be based on a combination of cumulative high school GPA and composite ACT scores. Please see the following index to determine your award eligibility:
