



## Zane State College – PTA Program – Student Outcomes Information

\*Information is from the December 2015 Annual Assessment Report to CAPTE and includes information for graduates of classes admitted in 2010, 2011 and 2012 who graduated respectively in 2012, 2013 and 2014.

### **Graduation Rate – 88.4%**

\*This number refers to the percentage of students who were admitted that ultimately graduated in 100 to 150% of the expected time to complete the program.

\*The number is actually 53 of 65 admitted students. However, certain types of student withdrawals are no longer counted 'against' the graduation rate. That is why the number appears higher than the expected 81.5%.

### **Licensure Exam Pass Rate – 100%** (54 of 54 graduates attempted to take the exam and passed)

\*This refers to ultimate pass rate and not first time pass rate.

\*Note that one licensee in 2012 chose to pursue higher education in lieu of seeking employment in the field.

\*Two licensed graduates in 2014 did not pursue PTA employment.

### **Employment Rate – 95.5%** (51 of 54 licensees are believed to have sought employment; 49 of 51 graduates are known to have found employment)

\*This reflects graduates who sought employment that were employed as PTAs within 6 months of taking and passing the licensure examination.

\*Note that one graduate from 2012 and one from 2014 have been unable to be contacted. The employment rate may well be 100% (51 of 51) but this cannot be confirmed.

\*Note that certain types of student withdrawals are no longer counted 'against' the graduation rate. That is the reason for the graduation rate appearing higher than expected when viewing raw data.
