- This FULL tuition scholarship (\$189 per credit hour) can be awarded for up to four consecutive semesters and can be used in addition to grants and community scholarships.
- Students must enroll the same calendar year as graduation.
- Students must have a high school and ZSC GPA of 2.75 or higher.

FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

- Awarded to any student with a 2.75 or higher GPA.
- Foundation awards vary from student to student and range from \$250 to full tuition.
- The award amount is based on a multitude of factors including GPA, program, volunteer experience, and financial need.

Zane State College Scholarship Application Process

Complete an online scholarship application at www.zanestate.edu/scholarships and upload a one-page, typed letter about yourself that includes your academic background, employment experience, career goals, community involvement, interests, and other information you would like considered. This will be blindly evaluated and scored and should be as thorough as possible.

Applicants should:

- Submit their high school transcript (showing cumulative GPA) and ACT scores (if applicable) to the ZSC Admissions Office. Graduating seniors should request their final transcript (with graduation date and final cumulative GPA) be sent immediately after graduation.
- Request official copies of all external college or university transcripts be sent to the ZSC Registrar's Office.

Notification

- Once all final documents are received and your file has been reviewed by the Scholarship Review Committee, you will be notified of eligibility in a Scholarship Award Notice (SAN) via US mail.
- Scholarship recipients will be required to sign and return the SAN and write a thank you letter to the donor(s) of their scholarship. The SAN will contain the name of the donor(s) and instructions for writing the thank you letter.
- Award letters are typically mailed in July for the upcoming academic year. More than \$200,000 is awarded to ZSC students annually.
