

## Zane State College Student Outcomes

### Student Graduation Rates

The chart below indicates graduation rates for the six most recent cohort years. Each cohort is defined as first-time, full-time degree/certificate-seeking students entering in fall semester of the cohort year. Graduation rates are defined as the total number of individuals from a given cohort who completed a credential within a given percent of normal time divided by the total number of students in the cohort. Graduation rates are calculated as a percentage of normal time to completion for the associated degree – e.g. a 2-year degree completed in 3 years would equate to graduating within 150% time to completion.

Rates below are current as of the publication of the 2017 IPEDS data feedback report. The 200% time to completion graduation rate for the 2013 cohort has not yet been published.
