



Zane State College – PTA Program Student Outcomes Information

*Information is from the December 2023 Annual Assessment Report to CAPTE and includes information for graduates of classes admitted in 2019 and 2020 who graduated respectively in 2021 and 2022.

Graduation Rate – 75% (18 of 24 students)

This number refers to the percentage of students who were admitted that ultimately graduated in 100 to 150% of the expected time to complete the program. Twenty-seven (27) students entered the program. Seventeen (17) graduated on time, one (1) graduated in 150% of the time, and 9 did not complete the program. Of those not completing, six (6) were due to academic deficit and three (3) for other reasons. Only students not graduating due to academic or clinical deficit are counted against the graduation rate.

Licensure Exam Pass Rate – 94.7% (18 of 19 students)

This number reflects the number of students/graduates who ultimately passed the NPTE for the PTA.

2021 – **Ten (10) of thirteen (13) passed on their first attempt.** Two (2) additional students passed on their second attempt. One (1) graduate did not pass. It is not known if they took the exam more than once.

2022 – **All six (6) students passed on their first attempt.**

Employment Rate – 100% (18 of 18 licensees)

*This reflects graduates eligible for employment, who sought it, and were employed as PTAs within 12 months of graduation/licensure passage. Graduates not passing the NPTE are not considered eligible for employment and do not count against employment rate.

In 2021, **76.9% (10 of 13) grads passed on the first attempt**. 2 additional graduates passed on the second attempt bringing the overall pass rate to 92.3%. It is not known whether the final graduate attempted to take the NPTE more than 1 time.

In 2022, **100% (6/6) graduates passed the exam on their first attempt**.
