



Academic Standing Policy

Academic Probation, Academic Suspension, and Academic Dismissal

Academic Warning

A student with an earned **term** Grade Point Average (GPA) that is less than 2.00 regardless of the student's cumulative GPA will be placed on academic warning. Students on academic warning are still considered to be in good standing.

Academic Probation

A student with a cumulative GPA that is less than 2.00.

Attempted Credit Hours	Cumulative GPA
0-12	1.99 to 1.01
13-24	1.99 to 1.24
25-30	1.99 to 1.49
31-45	1.99 to 1.74
46 or more	1.99 to 1.84

A student on Academic Probation shall meet an assigned Success Coach who will determine the required number of meetings.

Academic Suspension

Students will be placed on academic suspension if the cumulative GPA is below the following levels:

Attempted Credit Hours	Cumulative GPA
0-12	≤ 1.00
13-24	≤ 1.25
25-30	≤ 1.50
31-45	≤ 1.75
46 or more	≤ 1.85

A student on Academic Suspension shall complete recommendations set forth by the Academic Standing Committee. This may include, but is not limited to, enrolling in FYEX 0990 and completing mandatory Success Coach meetings (see appeal process on next page).

Academic Dismissal

A student who has been on Academic Probation or Academic Suspension and has not made progress in improving the student's cumulative GPA for three consecutive semesters will be academically dismissed. Academically dismissed students are eligible to reapply after two academic semesters.

Academic Suspension Appeal Process

Students placed on academic suspension have the right to appeal for extenuating circumstances. Students must complete the following steps to appeal:

1. Complete the Academic Suspension Appeal Form.
2. Submit the Academic Suspension Appeal Form to the Registrar's Office by the following deadlines:
 - Fall semester – first Wednesday of January no later than 10 a.m.
 - Spring semester and Summer Term - Wednesday before the term begins no later than 10 a.m.

The Academic Standing Committee will meet in a timely manner to review student appeals. Students will be notified of the appeal outcome before the start of the term. If a student's appeal is approved, the student will be placed on Academic Probation and must follow the guidelines provided by the Academic Standing Committee. A student who was placed on Academic Probation after a successful appeal must show at least minimal improvement with the cumulative GPA. A student may appeal a maximum of two times before being Academically Dismissed.
