Zane State College – PTA Program – Student Outcomes Information

*Information is from the December 2020 Annual Assessment Report to CAPTE and includes information for graduates of classes admitted in 2016 and 2017 who graduated respectively in 2018 and 2019.

Graduation Rate – 83.3% (30 of 36 students.)

*This number refers to the percentage of students admitted who graduated either on time or in 150% of the expected time.

Licensure Exam Pass Rate – 96.8% (30 of 31 graduates attempted to take the exam and passed.)

Employment Rate – 96.4% (27/28 licensees sought and found employment within the allotted timeframe.)

*This reflects graduates who sought employment that were employed as PTAs within 12 months of graduation/licensure, which ever came last.

One graduate could not be contacted. Employment rate at 12 months post-graduation/licensure for this 2 year period could well have been 100% but, cannot be substantiated.

*The one student not graduating with their class for “other reasons” in both 2018 do not count against the graduation rate of their cohort because they were for reasons other than academic deficit.

- In 2018 10 students passed in the first attempt, 4 passed in the second attempt and one student attempted the exam 3x and remained unsuccessful.
- In 2019 all 16 students passed on the first attempt.

2019	14 - Presumed	13	92.9%
Total	28	27	96.4% (27/28)

- Note that 13/14 graduates from 2019 are known to have found employment in the field within one year of becoming licensed. However, the Program Director was unable to reach one graduate to learn her employment status. Employment rate for the 2019 graduating class could well have been 100% but cannot be substantiated.
- Two students from the class of 2019 did not seek employment.
