



Zane State College Short-Term Certificate Scholarship

Funded by a grant from the Ohio Department of Higher Education

Scholarship funding is available to students enrolled for in demand short term certificate programs. Zane State College will award funds on a first come, first served basis to qualified students with unmet need, to cover the cost of tuition and fees. Preference will be given to students enrolled in certificates that are not eligible for federal financial aid.

Award: Up to \$2,000 per student for tuition and fees

Deadline: June 30, 2021 or until all funding is spent

Qualification: Here is an easy-to-use checklist to determine eligibility for this funding. Students need ONLY ONE criterion from each list.

Short Term Certificate

- Cyber Security
- Game Design
- Industrial Systems
- Medical Coding*
- Multi-Skilled Health Technician
- Real Estate*

*program not federal aid eligible

Qualifying Need

- Meets eligibility criteria for federal Pell Grant
- Unemployed as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic

Documents Needed

- Completed FAFSA (including verification, if requested)
- Copy of unemployment determination letter with qualifying date of March 13 or later

Documentation can be submitted to the Financial Aid Office. Students will be awarded scholarships in the order that approved, finalized documents are received. Funds are limited and will be awarded until all monies are used.
