



LECTURE/TRADITIONAL

This is a course taught in the traditional face-to-face format. Such courses will still utilize technology, such as online resources and activities, but these activities are not meant to replace in-class attendance.



BLENDED COURSE

A blended course is a course that will have at least one day of face-to-face meeting and the rest of the course is online.



ONLINE

An online course utilizes the Internet to deliver course content and assessment/testing completely online. Communication between students and faculty is also conducted online, and the class does not generally meet in person.



FLEX

A Flex course makes live classes available to students through video streaming. This gives students some flexibility with attendance, at the instructor's discretion.



ONLINE/LAB

The course is taught online, but there are open lab times for students to come to campus to get face-to-face instruction, if needed.



ONLINE/LECTURE

The course is taught online but has set virtual hours each week for live interaction.
