Hello Applicants,

Thank you for your interest in the Radiologic Technology program. Due to hospital restrictions on observation students, we have changed the observation guidelines for the 2023 application year. You will need to observe a minimum of 8 hours total. This can be done at one site, or several sites.

Please note that if you observe at just one site, you will only have to answer questions from site #1 & site #2 of the clinical observation documentation forms. You will not need to answer questions listed for site #3 or site #4.

You will also be required to interview a 2nd year RADT student. Please email Quest Folck at gfolck@zanestate.edu to obtain contact information on a 2nd year student. The format for the interview will follow APA guidelines and be double spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font. This paper needs to be included with your application Observation Validation forms. The following questions are required to be asked, along with any other questions you have for the student:

1. What advice would you give to someone interested in the program?
2. How hard is the program?
3. Is it beneficial to work full or part time during program?
4. How much time outside of class do you study?
5. What area of radiology is your favorite?
6. What is your plan after school?
7. What got you interested in the program?

Please note that if you observe at just one site, you will only have to answer questions from site #1 & site #2 of the clinical observation documentation. You will not need to answer questions listed for site #3 or site #4.
